Additionally, a professor and a student from our university have recently developed a prototype of a mechanical ventilator designed to pump oxygen and remove carbon dioxide from the lungs of individuals with breathing difficulties or those undergoing surgical procedures.

On this special day and anniversary, we take pride in honouring our distinguished professors and students for their contributions in an effort to prevent brain drain. At the same time, we strive to encourage those who have left to return—if not permanently, at least occasionally in what is known as "brain circulation."
